## **Nolensville Pk. / State Route 11 Widening**

**September 2024**

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### **Phase 1 Project Description:**

The project widens Nolensville Pike from a two-lane road to a five-lane road (including a dedicated turn lane and bike lanes). It stretches from south of Burkitt Road to near SR 254 (Old Hickory Boulevard). The proposed improvements are intended to address congestion, improve safety, and accommodate growth in this rapidly developing area.

Due to the size of improvements to SR 11, TDOT has split this project into two phases. Phase 1, from north of Mill Creek to near SR 254 in southern Davidson County, is currently under construction.

### **Update Regarding August Water Main Break:**

On August 30, 2024, an equipment operator employed by Civil Constructors struck at 24" water line while working on TDOT's Nolensville Pike widening project. As a results, several properties sustained damage.

Since the incident, representatives from TDOT and Civil Constructors have been meeting with homeowners and assisting with insurance claims. It is TDOT policy that contractors are responsible for any damage to private property during construction, and TDOT is working closely with Civil Constructors to ensure each property owner has the necessary information to move forward with receiving reimbursement for any damages.

The incident was an unfortunate accident and TDOT deeply regrets it took place. While utility issues arise during construction projects, this one should have been avoided as the water line struck was notated in project plans and Civil Constructors was aware of its location. The equipment operator who struck the line was terminated.

Moving forward, TDOT has been conducting regular internal meetings with representatives from Civil Constructors and Gresham Smith regarding status of repairs and insurance claims. Additionally, homeowners should notice an increased level in communication by Civil Constructors in regard to upcoming work that could impact private property.

### **Completed Work:**

- Drainage structures installed from Bluff Road to Holt Road and Brooklawn Drive to Shane Point
- Utility poles and buried utilities (water, sewer) placed



### **Active Work:**

- Construction started on retaining walls (seven total) and box culverts (three total)
- Grading operations
- Stream mitigation work
- Water, sewer, and gas installation
- Setting utility poles for overhead relocation



## Upcoming Work

- Grading operations with blasting as needed
- Stream relocations
- Underground and overhead utility relocation
- Holt Road closure and construction
