Progress Update

- West side of the bridge is being built over Whites Creek.
- Cedar Circle has been shut down for grading work and detour is in place.
- Grading work across from Abernathy Rd. is completed.
- Power poles have been placed on Clarksville Pike from W. Hamilton to Kings Lane.
- Comcast line has been relocated around the Whites Creek bridge.
- Moment slabs are being placed over the MSE retaining walls.

Anticipated Schedule

- Work will continue on the new West Hamilton alignment.
- Placing sod on slope across from Abernathy Rd.
- Traffic shift around Abernathy Rd.
- Moment slabs and parapet walls will be placed on top of the retaining walls.
- Power relocation will continue, including installation of temporary poles and relocating all utility power lines to these poles.
- Storm drain installation, and water and sewer line relocation will continue throughout the job.
