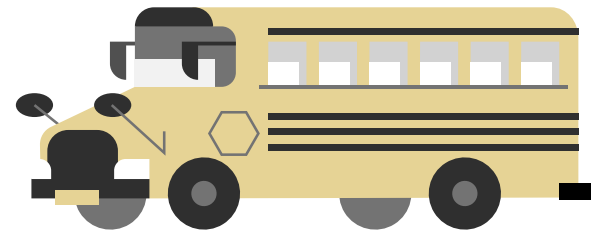

Purpose

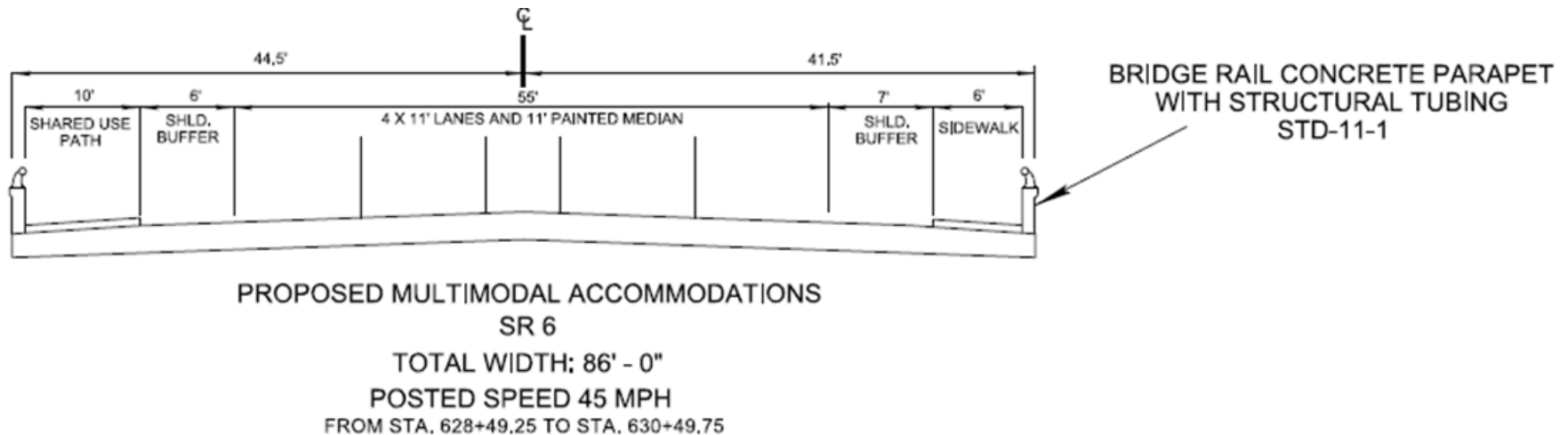
- Both bridges were constructed in **1955** and have each received an overall **poor condition rating**.
- The existing deck geometry and traffic safety features **do not meet current design specifications**
 - **West Fork Bridge:**
 - 28 tons for single-unit vehicles.
 - 40 tons for multi-use vehicles.
 - **East Fork Bridge:**
 - 34 tons for single-unit vehicles.
 - 40 tons for multi-unit vehicles.



*Standard School Bus:
12 - 18 tons*

Purpose

- Modernization & Enhanced Safety
 - Three-span concrete box bridges will replace the existing five-span concrete bridges
 - 10' shared-use path with 6' buffer, 6' sidewalk with 7' buffer on bridge
 - Bridge approaches: left shoulder will be widened to 16 feet; right shoulder to 13 feet for future multimodal accommodations



Schedule

- Collaboration with [PlanGallatin!](#) Long-Range Plan
- Bridges part of TDOT's 3-Year On-System Bridge Replacement Program
- Funded for construction this fiscal year
- Currently in June 2026 bid letting
- Project estimated start (utilities): Summer/Fall 2026
- Bridge work estimated start: Q1 2028
- Project estimated completion: Q4 2029

Phases & Traffic Impacts

- **Utilities Phase: 18 Months**
 - Temporary lane closures as needed
 - West Fork Bridge:
 - Closure of 2-way center turn lane over bridge
 - East Fork Bridge:
 - Center gore narrowed

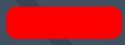

Traffic Phase 1: 10 Months

- **West Fork Bridge:**

- Closure of two WB travel lanes and 2-way center turn lane
- Traffic shifted to south side of SR 6 (one lane WB, one lane EB)

- **East Fork Bridge:**

- Closure of two WB travel lanes and center gore
- Traffic shifts to south side of SR 6 (one lane EB, one lane WB)
- SR 6 left turns onto Blue Jay Way/Harris Rd & Tulip Poplar Dr/Lakeshore Dr restricted for both directions
- WB SR 6 left turns into Lowes driveway restricted
- Left turns from unsignalized driveways onto SR 6 restricted

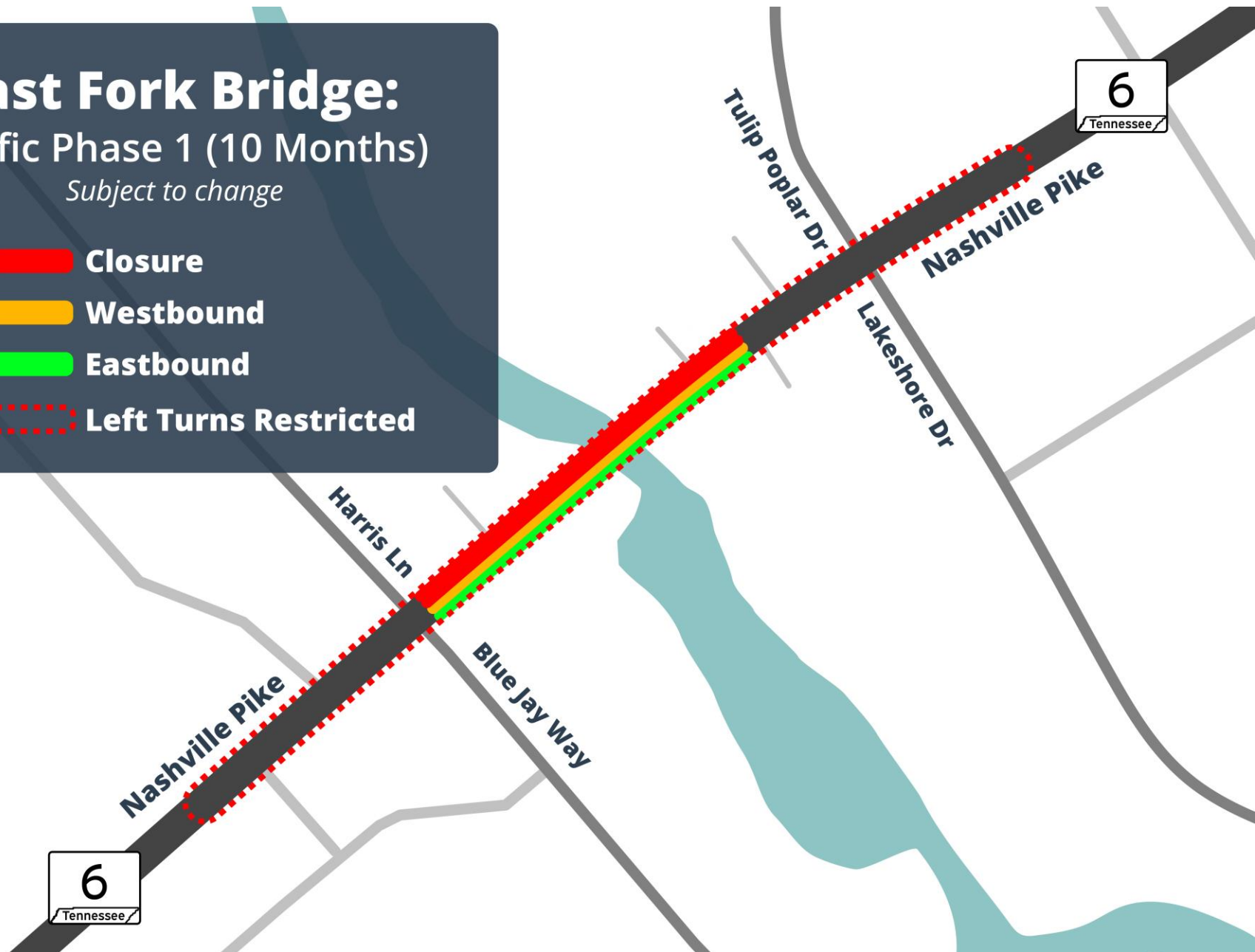

Traffic Phase 2: 10 Months

- **West Fork Bridge:**

- Closure of two EB travel lanes and 2-way center turn lane
- Traffic shifted to north side of SR 6 (one lane WB, one lane EB)

- **East Fork Bridge:**

- Closure of two WB travel lanes and center gore
- Traffic shifts to south side of SR 6 (one lane EB, one lane WB)
- SR 6 left turns onto Blue Jay Way/Harris Rd & Tulip Poplar Dr/Lakeshore Dr restricted for both directions
- WB SR 6 left turns into Lowes driveway restricted
- Left turns from unsignalized driveways onto SR 6 restricted

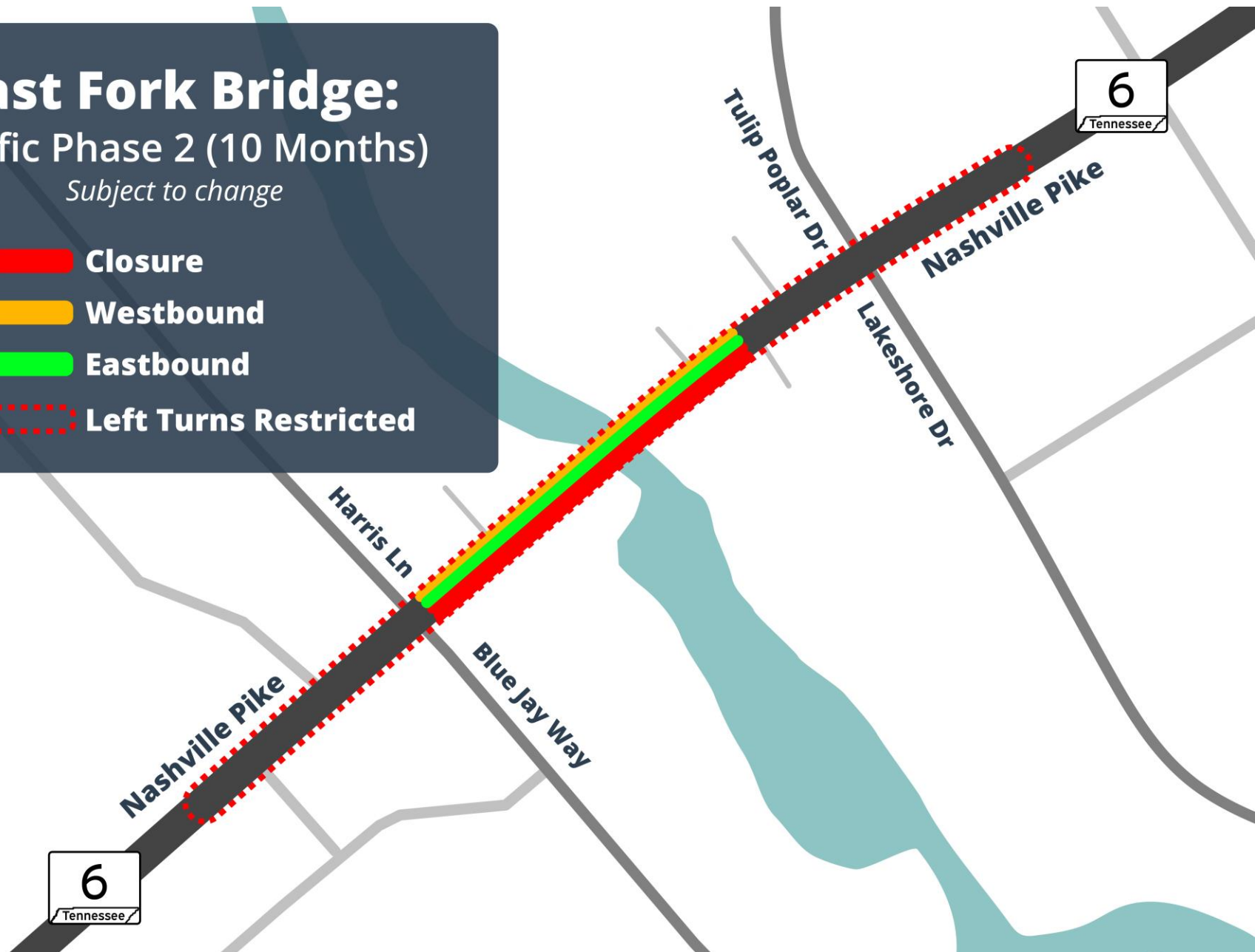

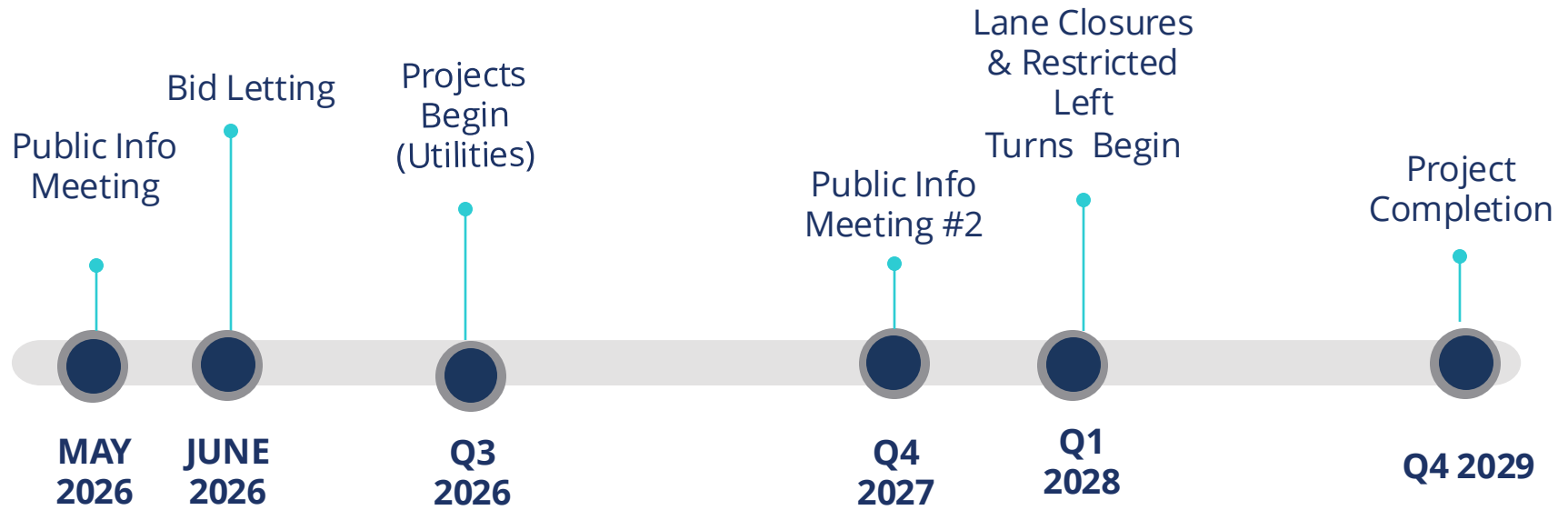
Phases & Traffic Impacts

- **Traffic Phase 3: 2 Months**
 - Nighttime (8 p.m. - 5 a.m.) closures for final paving and striping; one lane to remain open in each direction.

Additional Construction Details/Mitigation

- **Noise restrictions:** No demolition, pile driving, or blasting allowed between 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. through the duration of project.
- **Reduced Speed Limit:** 35 mph (East) & 40 mph (West)
- **GreenLea Boulevard:** Temporary signal to be placed at GreenLea Boulevard/Exit 14 eastbound off-ramp
