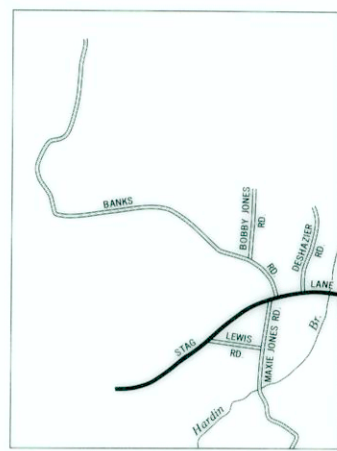

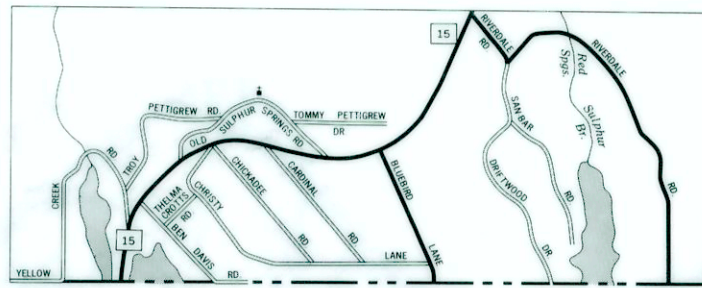
POLYCONIC PROJECTION

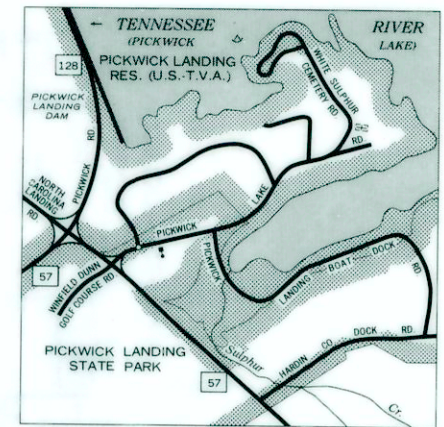
AREA N.W. OF BETHEL

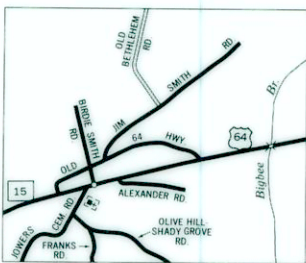
AREA SOUTH OF RED SULPHUR SPRINGS

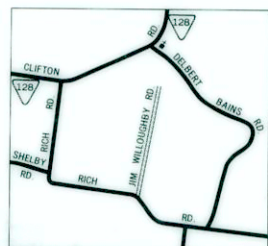
AREA EAST OF PYBURNS

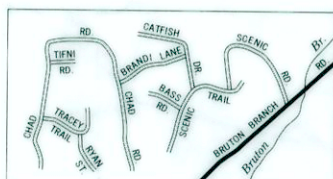

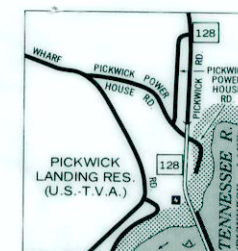

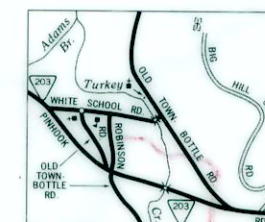
AREA SOUTH OF BUCKTOWN

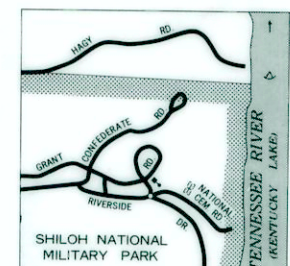
AREA N.E. OF PICKWICK VILLAGE

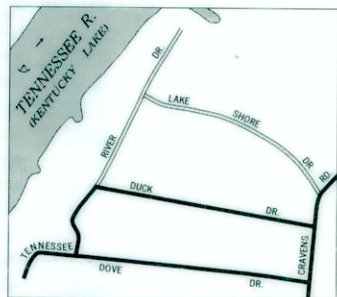
AREA SOUTH OF PYBURNS

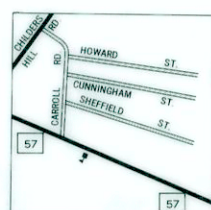

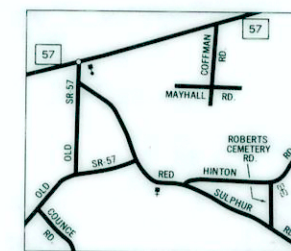

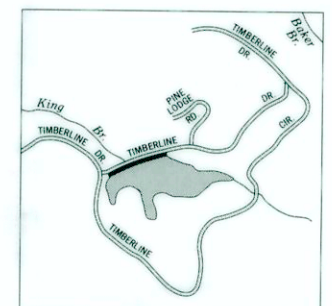
AREA NORTH OF OAK GROVE

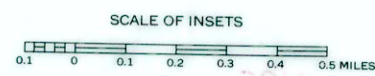

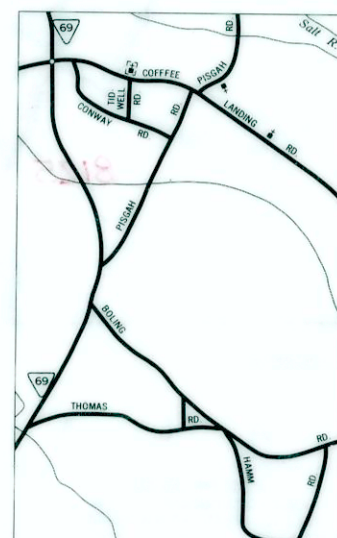
