PROCEDURES AND OPERATIONS

- 1) Product representatives shall first ensure the appropriate ITS Qualified Product List section has been established by the Tennessee Department of Transportation for the proposed product. The QPL sections can be found on TDOT's ITS QPL website (<https://www.tn.gov/tdot/intelligent-transportation-systems/approved-its-products-list.html>).
- 2) Representatives should submit their product information along with a completed and signed "ITS New Product Form". Submissions should be sent electronically in a .pdf format to:

- 3) The TDOT Traffic Operations Division will examine the submitted "ITS New Product Form", product specification compliance form and all accompanying documentation. Testing of device or material properties may be requested at this time. Please do not submit any product samples until requested to do so.
- 4) When requested by TDOT Traffic Operations, the product representative shall provide additional information regarding their product submittal. Upon complete review of all product information and required testing, the product will be designated as approved or not approved. Regardless of the determination, all product submittals received with a completed "ITS New Product Form" will be given due consideration and be evaluated by the TDOT Traffic Operations Division.
- 5) Products that are rejected, for any reason, may be resubmitted for consideration after a moratorium period of two years from the date of rejection.
- 6) This program is intended for the evaluation of new and/or proprietary products that are market-ready.
- 7) Data resulting from an evaluation of the submitted product is public information and will not be considered privileged. All information developed during this product evaluation may be released by the Tennessee Department of Transportation at its discretion.
