NOTE 1: WHERE THERE IS AN OPPOSITE LEFT TURN LANE APPROACH IN THE SAME ALIGNMENT AS THE LEFT TURN LANE, THE LEFT TURN SIGNAL HEAD IS OFFSET TWO FEET (MIN.) CLOSER TO THE THROUGH LANE IN ORDER TO INCREASE THE APPROACH'S SIGNAL HEAD VISIBILITY.

NOTE 2: THIS TRAFFIC SIGNAL HEAD CAN ONLY BE USED THROUGH INTERIM APPROVAL 17 (1A-17) OPTIONAL USE OF THREE-SECTION FLASHING YELLOW ARROW SIGNAL FACE. CONTACT TDOT'S STATE TRAFFIC ENGINEER TO REQUEST PERMISSION AND OBTAIN APPROVAL TO UTILIZE THIS TRAFFIC SIGNAL HEAD.
