
The General Assembly's historic investment of \$3.3B calls for a comprehensive approach for prioritizing and programming projects across the state.

\$3 Billion Total


Allocated to State Transportation **Projects**

\$750 Million for EACH Region







Initial Feasibility Analysis

Focused on limited access corridor segments to assess the financial viability of adding Choice Lanes

Corridors analyzed and combined into **six potential projects** to be the focus of the market sounding and project screening exercises

Additional screening using a financial modeling tool




Transportation Modernization Board

- Five total members
 - Commissioner of Transportation, Chair
 - Governor or Governor's Designee
 - Lt. Governor's Appointee: Filled
 - Speaker's Appointee: Unfilled
 - Governor's Appointee: Unfilled
- Terms statutorily began Oct. 1, 2023
- TDOT staff preparing for commencement of the board
 - Draft bylaws complete
 - Creation of website for public notice and resources
 - Developing training and educational materials for board members and the public
