MANDATORY:

• Complete the house of worship self-assessments and create or update an emergency plan

INTERNAL FOCUS:

- Create or have an emergency planning team in place, with a coordinator.
- Conduct at least one emergency preparedness training or tabletop exercise based on your emergency plan with staff and members.
- Financial records and insurance are up to date (as described in the ReadyTN Faith self-assessment) and stored securely.
- Participate in a ReadyTN Faith, TEMA, or FEMA training in person or online (links available in the Resources section of the self-assessments and emergency operations plan template).

MEMBER FOCUS:

- Communications: Create a communications plan to contact members in the event of an emergency. Have updated online contact information (website, Google, social media).
- Educate members on your emergency plan through drills and/or exercises, conducting at least one evacuation drill each year.
- Promote individual emergency preparedness to members, through a handout, newsletter, or other means.
