

Notice of Change in Medicaid State Plan

The Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Finance & Administration is providing official notification, pursuant to 42 CFR § 447.205, of intent to file an amendment to the Medicaid State Plan. This amendment will be filed with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

The purpose of this amendment is to reflect a change in TennCare's reimbursement methodology for nursing facility services. For some time, TennCare has worked with the Tennessee Health Care Association (the nursing facility industry association), nursing facility providers, residents and their family members, and other stakeholders to design and implement a quality- and acuity-adjusted reimbursement methodology for nursing facilities. Although TennCare payments to nursing facilities are not governed by the State Plan (since they are part of the managed care program operated under the TennCare II demonstration), this SPA will update Tennessee's State Plan to align with this new reimbursement methodology and with State law, primarily for purposes of crossover payments. Under the new quality- and acuity-adjusted reimbursement methodology, payment determination components include acuity adjusted direct care, non-acuity adjusted direct care, quality, administration, fair market value capital, and a cost-based component. The proposed effective date of the amendment is July 1, 2018. This amendment is not anticipated to result in a net increase or decrease in annual aggregate expenditures.
