MOPD Tips

Please note: MOPD is the Medicaid effective date. It is the date that a nursing facility certifies that Medicaid reimbursement for NF services will begin and Medicaid will be the only payer source. This means that ALL other payer sources have ceased paying including Medicare, private insurance and private payer.

The PAE may be submitted without an MOPD date, in which case the MOPD shall be submitted by the facility when it is known. Enrollment into CHOICES Group 1 and eligibility for reimbursement of NF services shall be permitted only upon submission of a MOPD. The effective date of CHOICES enrollment and Medicaid reimbursement of NF services shall not be earlier than the MOPD. It is a known date and can only be known when Medicaid is approved.
