The Specialized Comprehensive Treatment Team (SCTT) provides intensive, community-based care for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) and co-occurring behavioral health needs. Through coordinated, multidisciplinary services, SCTT promotes behavioral stability, improves daily functioning, strengthens family and caregiver supports, reduces crises, and helps individuals remain safely in their homes and communities.

Who Can Benefit?

SCTT may be appropriate for individuals who:

- Are age 12 or older with an intellectual and/or developmental disability (IDD)
- Have significant mental health or behavioral challenges
- Have experienced an increase in behavioral incidents within the past 30 days
- Are struggling at home, school, work, or in the community
- Are at risk of hospitalization or losing their current home, school, or community placement

How We Help

SCTT provides personalized, team-based care that may include:

- Comprehensive behavioral health and functional assessments
- Individualized treatment planning
- Counseling for individuals and families
- Behavior support and skills training
- Crisis prevention and intervention
- Care coordination with physicians, schools, and community providers
- 24/7 crisis response when needed
