# PCMH-Application and Selection Timeline



*2 month application window*

**May 1, 2017**

- PCMH application will be opened for potential respondents\*
- Only 1 application should be submitted per Tax ID

**June 30, 2017**

- Deadline to submit applications, with State fielding questions as needed

**August 1, 2017**

- State to review submissions and announce Wave 2 PCMHs to the applicants
- Organizations may begin contracting for PCMH with MCOs

**January 1, 2018**

- Organizations begin Wave 2 of the TennCare PCMH program
- All Wave 1 organizations continue participation

\*Note: Wave 1 PCMH organizations do not need to reapply

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# Delay for All Neonatal Episodes

- The three neonatal episodes in wave 6 will **not** be included in the June 2017 preview reports.
  - Age 31 weeks or less episode
  - Age 32-36 weeks episode
  - Age 37+ weeks episode
- The delay is due to issues with claims data, e.g. separating mother and baby claims. We will continue to partner with MCOs and other stakeholders to resolve these issues.

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## Reports Will Be Released on June 6, 2017

- The June quarterly reports will be posted to the MCO portals on Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
- The delay of the neonatal episodes pushed back our reporting timeline from the end of May to June 6<sup>th</sup>.
