

TennCare PCMH Program Update: 1.29.2021



The ADT and Member Search sections will now include data that will help with care coordination, as outlined below. Please see the attached email announcement that further outlines the changes.

- Member’s THL status more easily identified/displayed
- Member’s contact information available in exports
- Date and time stamp for receipt of ADT information

WCV and W30 Core Quality Metrics Threshold Reminder. Due to the timing of the release of the HEDIS specifications, we have been unable to provide the thresholds for the Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits (WCV) metric and the Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (W30) metric to date. However, TennCare and the MCOs will be working this spring to determine thresholds and will provide those as soon as we are able. Please also keep in mind that the CCT will display proxy thresholds for WCV and W30 until the new thresholds are determined.
