**Staff Recommendation**           For discussion only

**Background**                              The 2022-23 TSAA year-end expenditures totaled \$119.6 million. This represents awards made to 64,100 students.

The Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship (TELS) concluded the 2022-23 academic year by providing almost \$450 million to over 146,000 students. These figures include the Tennessee Promise Scholarship, which is funded by both TELS revenue and endowment investment earnings.
