VISION STATEMENT FEEDBACK

- After the July meeting, we gathered input from staff, school operators, external stakeholders, legislators, and other Tennessee state agencies regarding the current draft of the vision statement.
- We collaborated with Commissioner Griscom to refine the statement, ensuring it:
 - Accurately reflects our ongoing efforts
 - Challenges us while maintaining a forward-focused perspective
 - Is concise
- After consultation with Chair Richards, two vision statement options are presented today for consideration.



VISION STATEMENT FEEDBACK

Updated Vision Statement Options

- *“By authorizing and supporting excellent **public school choices**, we positively impact the quality of a Tennessee education, enabling every student to achieve their full potential and to prepare for a successful life experience.”*
- *“By authorizing and supporting excellent **public charter schools**, we positively impact the quality of a Tennessee education, enabling every student to achieve their full potential and to prepare for a successful life experience.”*



MISSION STATEMENT

- There are four mission statement options included on the one-pager for review and feedback.
- We plan to apply the same strategy to our feedback process as we did with the vision statement, but we wanted to gather your initial thoughts before starting that process.



NEXT STEPS

- **Mission Statement Approval:**
 - Staff will present an updated mission statement in January 2025 for discussion and vote by the Commissioners.
- **Strategic Plan Revisions:**
 - Commission staff will incorporate feedback received through the visioning process to revise the Commission's strategic plan.
 - There will be opportunities for Commissioners to provide input and feedback on proposed changes prior to bring an update plan for approval in March 2025.
