



## **TISA Accountability Report 2025**

The Tennessee Investment in Student Achievement (“TISA”) public school funding formula was first implemented for the 2023-24 school year. Pursuant to T.C.A. § 49-3-112, each school district is required to submit an accountability report to the Tennessee Department of Education by November 1 of each year. This report must be presented for public comment prior to submission.

The Commission set goals for the first TISA Accountability Report at the October 2023 meeting. The goal statements are:

- 70% of students will score proficient on the third grade ELA TCAP by 2030
- Less than 12% of students will be chronically absent in the K-8th grade band by 2030. Less than 20% of students will be chronically absent in the 9th-12th grade band by 2030.
- 70% of students will score proficient on the 3rd-8th grade math and ELA TCAP by 2030.
- By 2026, 100% of schools authorized by the Tennessee Public Charter School Commission will earn an average rating of “Meets Standard” on Comparative Performance (3a and 3b) of the Academic Section of the School Performance Framework.
- The Tennessee Public Charter School Commission will maintain a TVAAS Composite Score of Level 4+ every year.

The TISA Accountability Report must be submitted each year. The report must include an explanation how the district's stated goals can be met within the district's budget and a description of how the district's budget and expenditures from the prior school year enabled the district to make progress toward the stated student achievement goals.
