



4211 – Work-Based Learning Program

ADOPTED: April 9, 2021

MONITORING: Annually

Students shall have access to a system of structured work-based learning (WBL) experiences that allow them to apply classroom theories to practical problems as well as explore career options, where work-based learning programs are offered.¹

If programs are offered, Each authorized charter school shall adopt procedures to govern the efficient administration of the WBL program in accordance with State Board Policy 2.103. Such procedures shall include, among other things, a process for evaluation and assessment of the program to ensure that it is of high quality and meets the needs of students.
