Esteemed Board Members:

I am writing you today in support of approval of LEAD Southeast Elementary. Currently, I serve as the principal of LEAD Southeast Middle School and have been a member of this school community for five years. Since my time at LEAD Southeast, I've learned of the immense desire that the Southeast Nashville community has for an elementary school option offered by LEAD. Since 2013, families and students have been well served by our middle and high schools, with data that consistently outperforms schools in our district. In fact, several categories are currently beating State averages based on 23-24 TNReady data. We saw a 10% proficiency jump in ELA this past school year, along with an 11% increase in math. We know we have middle and high school models that work for students and families, so the opportunity to open an elementary school will only increase the success that students will experience at LEAD Southeast Middle School. Our academic and elementary teams will ensure that students arrive to the middle school near, at, or above grade level in core content areas and we will build upon that success at the middle school to open doors for LEAD graduates down the road. The opportunity to send even more kids to our high school proficient in core content areas will lead to higher ACT scores and hundreds of thousands of more scholarship dollars for our graduates. We are hungry for that opportunity!

At LEAD, we believe in serving the students we have to prepare them for college and life. We also believe that Southeast Middle is the place where every child in Southeast Nashville belongs. Let me end with an anecdote from a recent interaction I had with a community member. During summer professional development, our middle school teachers were gearing up for three hours of lesson practice and feedback. I ran to the gas station at the end of Metroplex Drive (where our school is located) to buy a few snacks. While paying, the cashier saw my LEAD Southeast lanyard, looked me in the eyes, and said, "honey...when are y'all getting an elementary school? Y'all are the best we have out here." The cashier was not a parent or relative of a student, just a community member who cares deeply for the success of the kids in this part of Nashville. Approving LEAD Southeast Elementary is not "taking a chance," it is simply an extension of the LEAD Southeast campus that will continue delivering on its mission and promise to families.

In the beginning of the year, we spend lots of time placing students into the appropriate intervention levels. Time and time again, our students who are LSE Middle returners are seen moving up through the intervention levels and making significant gains while our new-to-LSE Middle students continue to be the students who need the lowest levels of intervention. These indicate significant gaps in foundational skills potentially as a result of their elementary schools not adequately ensuring they master basic reading and math calculation. Students without IEPs or any previous identifications are continually arriving to LEAD Southeast Middle School requiring addition and subtraction math intervention and decoding and fluency reading interventions. With LEAD Southeast Elementary, LEAD would ensure students receive high quality Tier I instruction along with all necessary tiered interventions, to send students to middle school with strong foundational mastery. Students deserve an elementary education that successfully prepares them for accessing middle school content.

Good Morning Members of TPCSC,

My name is Dr. Jamie S. Jenkins. I currently serve as an Assistant Principal with LEAD Public Schools. I am writing in support of creating two new elementary schools in the LEAD network. I offer a unique perspective in this matter, as a student, parent, and employee. I spent 38 years of my life in MNPS (14 as a student, 1 year as a parent, and 24 years as a teacher and administrator). I retired from MNPS in 2022. I had no intention of returning to the education field. After successfully opening and growing a few businesses in the year following retirement, I woke up one morning missing the daily interactions with students.

I researched how I could best serve the families of Nashville. I re-considered MNPS. I looked at Universities. I looked at private schools and charter schools. I considered the mission of each. I asked myself, "who is doing the work to truly impact kids in a positive way?" While all had strengths, I ultimately decided to interview for district positions and with LEAD. I was offered several positions during that time, but ultimately decided on LEAD. Keep in mind, this was one of the lowest paying positions I was offered, and as I expressed in those interviews, it was no longer about the money for me, but who is making the most meaningful impact on kids. For me, MNPS was out of the equation. My experiences there, while enjoyable and rewarding, did not culminate with a strong belief that MNPS was meeting the standard of care that the city needs in an education system.

After sitting down with Dwayne Tucker, it became very clear that, like me, it was not about the money. He spoke about doing what was best for kids, and he gave example after example of how this is played out every day at LEAD. I was not convinced, but was confident enough to find out more. I spoke to other LEAD employees--teachers and leaders--and they seemed to echo Mr. Tucker's statements.

I started with LEAD at the beginning of the 23-24 school year, and have been pleased with that decision. What I have found with LEAD is a deep passion for celebrating kids, fostering a love for learning in kids, and being very intentional about ensuring that high quality instruction happens in the classroom. Because LEAD provides an expanded level of instructional support with Instructional Managers, and divides the management roles of the school leadership at the school level, we are able to focus more on instruction, student support, and facilities operation at a higher level. In MNPS, after 16 years as an administrator, I was solely responsible for each of those very important tasks, which meant that I had to spread my time to each of them. As you know, it is a challenge to be great at one thing when you are spread thin.

The result at LEAD has been just as you saw in the hearing--LEAD is outpacing MNPS in test scores across the board. While not perfect, LEAD is doing the work with the same kids as MNPS. I ask you to imagine, how

much more impact we can have starting with the youngest students in our city. I know this to be true--the elementary team that has been assembled is top tier. Dr. Ricki Gibbs, who is leading the charge, was a proven exceptional elementary principal, with a number of awards. During the 2020 school year, I sent my sons to Warner Elementary, where he transformed the school I attend as an elementary student, into a remarkable school. My sons left Warner Elementary energized and prepared. My youngest son left in the gifted program.

Both of the identified LEAD Elementary Principals are successful, veteran educators and have served as principals of schools for years. I accepted the role of being an Assistant Principal of one of the schools--a role I requested--in lieu of a head principal role. I have over 25 years of experience, with 17+ of those years being an administrator (assistant and head principal). I have 4 successful children of my own. I grew up in a diverse, yet impoverished single parent home in East Nashville. I have spent my career having a positive impact in the lives of kids. That fire still lives in me.

I ask you to consider the current academic data--it's outshines MNPS. I ask you to consider the qualitative data--LEAD discipline marks outshine MNPS. I ask you to consider stakeholder survey data--LEAD is providing an amazing service to the community. I ask you to consider the feeling of joy that permeates within the walls of LEAD schools--It far outweighs what I experienced in MNPS. One would only need to google LEAD Senior Signing Day or attend one of our campus's cultural celebrations. Finally, I ask you to consider, how great the impact we will have when we are afforded the opportunity to care, teach, and develop students from Kindergarten to college, with an amazing team of diverse and experienced leaders who not only know how to educate youth, but who have proven it, and are deeply committed to the care, growth, and learning of our youth. THAT EXCITES ME!

I ask that you approve the application to grant LEAD Public Schools two new elementary schools--LEAD Southeast Elementary and LEAD Cameron Elementary.
