#### **INTERIM REVIEW OVERVIEW**



#### **INTERIM REVIEW**

- T.C.A. §49-13-121(d)
  - An interim review of a charter school shall be conducted by the chartering authority under guidelines developed by the department of education in the fifth year of a charter school's initial period of operation and also in the fifth year following any renewal of a charter agreement.
- The interim review is intended to be a rigorous review of a charter school's performance and progress toward meeting the performance goals stated in the charter agreement



# **INTERIM REVIEW PROCESS**

- 1. Submission of an interim review report by the operator, received by December 1.
- 2. Extended school site visit by the Commission staff including interviews with stakeholders and a review of the entire performance record over the life of the charter agreement.
- 3. Commission staff review of previous annual reports in accordance with the authorizer's School Performance Framework.
- 4. A Commission-issued interim review report detailing the evaluation of the school and any subsequent feedback or corrective action plans as necessary.

## **OVERALL FINDINGS**

- Bluff City High School is currently <u>off-track</u> for renewal in the next five years.
- In accordance with Commission Policy 3.400 Charter School Intervention, Commission staff recommends Bluff City be placed on Probationary Status for the 2022-2023 School Year for:
  - Continued failure to meet performance targets (state accountability, charter contract, or performance frameworks)
- If approved by the Commission, the Notice of Probationary Status will result in a **Corrective Action Plan**, which "shall include specific improvement objectives, responsible person(s) for each action, technical assistance requirements (if applicable), a schedule, and indicators of success)."



# PLAN OF CORRECTION

- All items off track or severely off track for renewal are a part of the plan of correction.
- Commission staff will share these items along with improvement objectives with Bluff City leadership and governing board.
- Bluff City will develop a plan of correction and submit it to Commission staff by September 1, 2022, that includes:
  - Improvement objectives
  - Parties responsible
  - Schedules and timelines
  - Indicators of success
