#### IDEA Administrative Complaint

- In December 2022, an IDEA Administrative Complaint was filed against one of the Commission's authorized charter schools. As the LEA, the Commission is responsible for responding to the complaint through the Department of Education's process.
- Kelly Kroneman and Ashley Thomas worked with the charter school, Rocketship Dream Community Prep, and the Department of Education to respond to the complaint and completed the identified corrective actions.
- As of March 2, 2023, the corrective actions were complete, and the Department of Education closed the file.
