SUBJECT: 2023 Commission LEA Policy Updates

- LEA Policy 2200 School Operating Budget
 - Updated to require the charter school's governing body to adopt and operate under an annual budget from July 1 to June 30
- LEA Policy 2400 Revenue and School Fees
 - Moved the semi-annual reporting requirement regarding the receipt of grants to an as-needed basis
- LEA Policy 2402 Investment of Funds
 - Removes the annual reporting requirement regarding the investment of funds
- LEA Policy 3201 School Safety
 - Charter schools are required to provide school safety plans to local law enforcement, Department of Education, and Department of Safety by July 1
 - Removes duplicative language regarding safety instruction
- LEA Policy 3202 Emergency Preparedness
 - Charter schools are required to conduct one (1) incident command and one (1) emergency bus drill annually
- LEA Policy 3400 Transportation
 - Removes reference to the former BEP funding related to transportation
- LEA Policy 4206 Homebound Instruction
 - Adds clarification regarding homebound placement for students with disabilities and removes the language related to covid-19 quarantining
- LEA Policy 4212 Virtual Instruction
 - Removes language related to covid-19 quarantining
- LEA Policy 4400 Instructional Materials
 - Introduces language regarding school library requirements
- LEA Policy 4406 Internet Safety
 - Introduces two (2) additional areas that charter school policies are required to address



- LEA Policy 4502 Parent Involvement
 - Requires charter schools to inform parents of their right to review all surveys, analyses, and evaluations

• LEA Policy 4603 Promotion and Retention

- Sets forth requirements surrounding 3rd grade promotion and retention, in alignment with legislative updates
- Introduces additional reports to be submitted by charter schools; clarifies state assessment scoring weights for grades 3-5
- LEA Policy 5118 Background Investigations
 - Establishes that charter school leaders are responsible for ensuring that each employee responsible for criminal history record information is trained properly and timely
- LEA Policy 6303 Reporting of Crimes
 - Adds the requirement that charter school leaders also notify the director of schools of any assault, battery, or vandalism endangering life, health, or safety committed by a student on school property immediately
- LEA Policy 6309 Zero Tolerance
 - Introduces threatening mass violence on school property or at a school related activity as a zero-tolerance offense
- LEA Policy 6317 Remands and Student Disciplinary Hearing Authority
 - Allows the head of the charter school to modify a zero-tolerance expulsion
- LEA Policy 6400 Student Wellness and Health Services
 - Introduces language permitting the administration of anti-seizure medication by properly trained staff in an emergency situation
- LEA Policy 6403 Communicable Diseases
 - Requires charter schools to provide parents and guardians with information about meningococcal disease and influenza at the beginning of every school year
- LEA Policy 6409 Child Abuse
 - Requires charter schools to submit the child abuse coordinator's contact information to DCS and TPCSC by September 30 of each school year
- LEA Policy 6500 Restraint and Isolation



- Requires charter schools who administer isolation or physical restraint to a student receiving SPED services to report the incident immediately
- Requires the observation and evaluation of an isolated or restrained student receiving SPED services within a reasonable time
- Requires the creation of a record regarding the isolation or restraint of a student receiving SPED services in TNPulse
- LEA Policy 6600 Student Records and Confidentiality
 - Requires charter schools to receive parents and/or guardians written, informed, and voluntarily signed consent prior to a student's participation in a survey, analysis, or evaluation
