CURRENT 3RD GRADE PATHWAYS

- 3rd Grade
 - Multiple pathways for promotion for students who score "below" or "approaching" on TCAP
 - Take a retest and achieve proficiency on ELA TCAP
 - Participation in a learning loss summer camp
 - Participation in 4th grade tutoring
 - New pathway: a student is at or above the 50th percentile on the most recently administered state-provide benchmark assessment if the student opts into tutoring during the 4th grade.



CURRENT 4TH GRADE PATHWAYS

4th Grade

- Current pathway for promotion: A student who was promoted to the 4th grade with required tutoring must meet an adequate growth on 4th grade ELA TCAP to be promoted to the 5th grade.
- The State Board of Education approved the calculation on February 16, 2024, and districts received student-level calculations the week of March 4.
- Districts will receive results on adequate growth for students by July 1.
