



## Commission Statement on 2024-2025 Reward Schools & Exemplary District Status

Today, the State Board of Education approved the list of schools and districts achieving the highest overall federal accountability scores, including Reward Schools. The Tennessee Public Charter School Commission (“Commission”) is thrilled to announce that five schools in our portfolio met these criteria and have been named Reward Schools for the 2024-2025 school year: **Cornerstone Prep Lester Campus, KIPP Antioch College Prep Elementary, KIPP Antioch College Prep Middle, Libertas School of Memphis, and Rocketship Dream Community Prep.** These schools all achieved a score of at least 3.1 out of 4 across four indicators in federal accountability data. Those indicators are achievement, growth, English language proficiency, and chronic absenteeism. This is the second consecutive year achieving Reward status for KIPP Antioch College Prep Elementary and Libertas School of Memphis. We want to sincerely thank our school staff, students, and families for all their hard work and look forward to them continuing their track records of success.

The Commission is also excited to announce that as a district, **we achieved the highest possible determination, Exemplary, with our portfolio scoring in the 92nd percentile statewide.** This is the first time the Commission has received Exemplary status, and we are extremely proud to be one of only fourteen districts in Tennessee to achieve this designation. Since the General Assembly created the Commission in 2019, we have strived to set high standards and hold our schools accountable, and the designations released by the State Board of Education today show the results of those high standards and rigorous oversight.
