



1803 – Smoke Free Environment

ADOPTED: February 5, 2021

REVISED: July 25, 2025

MONITORING: Annually

All uses of tobacco, electronic/battery operated devices, vapor products, and all other associated paraphernalia are prohibited in all indoor facilities used to provide regular or routine K-12 education services and within all enclosed school buildings.¹ Smoking is not allowed within one hundred (100) feet of any entrance into a school building, in any public seating area, in bleachers for sporting events, or in public restrooms.²

Signs shall be posted on each main building entrance to notify students, employees, and all other persons visiting the school that the use of these products is prohibited. The following notice shall be prominently posted for elementary or secondary school sporting events (including at each ticket booth): *Smoking is prohibited by law in seating areas and in restrooms.*³

Authorized charter schools may adopt further policy at their discretion, provided it is in accordance with federal and state law.
