2020 WMA WATERFOWL INSTRUCTIONS

- You may apply at any TWRA license agent, at any TWRA regional office, or online at www.gooutdoorstennessee.com. If you encounter any problems while applying, please email TWRA.QuotaHunts@tn.gov or call 615-781-6621 during regular business hours (8:00 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. CDT). Do not mail this instruction sheet to TWRA.
- You may begin applying July 2, 2020. The deadline is midnight, July 26, 2020.
- No person may apply more than once. If two or more applications are submitted representing one individual, that individual's applications will be rejected and the individual will be subject to prosecution.
- A party must be established by a party leader who will create the party. A party number will be assigned to the leader and anyone wishing to join the party must have that party number when applying. Once the application is complete, the party number will be printed on the receipt. A party may not exceed 8 members.
- Applicants must be 16 years of age or older to apply.
- No edits will be made to any applications after the deadline. You may select up to 24 choices. Do not use the same hunt code more than once.
- Successful applicants must possess all appropriate licenses and permits and a confirmation number issued by TWRA to hunt. Hunting guests must also possess all appropriate licenses and permits.
- Reservations are nontransferable. Any person violating this rule and regulation is subject to having their reservation and/or hunting privileges revoked and may be subject to prosecution.
- Successful applicants with an email address associated with their TWRA license account will be emailed their blind permit. For successful applicants without an email address, TWRA will mail this information.
- Receipt of application does not constitute permission to participate in the hunt.

WHEN APPLYING AT A LICENSE AGENT

- You may apply at any TWRA license agent. Applicants must have valid, current state license(s) to participate in waterfowl hunting for the area you are applying for in order to be drawn for a blind. If you do not have current licenses, you will be disqualified from the draw.
- You will need to provide the license agent with your date of birth, last name, and one of the following: your Tennessee Driver's license, your TWRA ID number, or the last four of your Social Security number.
- When applying in person, you must remain until your application is processed to verify that the information is correct and to receive your receipt with your confirmation number.

WHEN APPLYING ON THE INTERNET

- You must have valid, current state license(s) to participate in waterfowl hunting for the area you are applying for in order to be drawn for a blind. If you do not have current licenses you will be disqualified from the draw.
- Go to <https://QuotaHunt.GoOutdoorsTennessee.com>. Enter the information as requested.
- Once your application is complete. You may view your application (including party members) by logging back into the address above.
- You may edit your application until the deadline.
- No application may be submitted or edited after the deadline.

DRAWING PROCEDURES

- Using the "luck of the draw" method, an applicant is randomly selected by the computer. The hunt choices are reviewed in the order designated on the application until a choice with quota remaining is found or the application runs out of choices.
- If blinds remain for any area at the conclusion of the drawing, a vacancy drawing will be conducted using applicants (individuals and groups) who were not successful with their prioritized choices in the order in which they were chosen. Applicants will be randomly assigned a vacant blind. Prioritized choices are not considered in the vacancy drawing.
