## GENERAL APPLICATION INFORMATION

- **The application period opens on June 12, 2024.** The deadline is at **11:59 p.m. CDT on July 24, 2024.**
- A **\$12 non-refundable application fee** and a vendor fee is assessed to each application, except for individuals possessing a valid Annual, Lifetime or Senior Sportsman License. Receipt and deposit of application fee(s) does not constitute permission to participate in the hunt. **Application fee(s) are non-refundable.**
- Applicants may select **up to 16 hunt choices** and rank them in order of preference.
- Applicants should review their application prior to submission and verify all information (name, hunt choices, etc.) upon completion to confirm accuracy.
- Ensure that you have a valid and accurate email address on your [www.gooutdoorstennessee.com](http://www.gooutdoorstennessee.com) account. A receipt, which serves as proof of application and hunt choices, will be sent to the email address on your account.
- **Only parties with 50-75 party members will be accepted** into the drawing.
- Once your application is complete, you may review your application (including party members) by logging into [www.quotahunt.gooutdoorstennessee.com](http://www.quotahunt.gooutdoorstennessee.com). Applications may be edited until the deadline.
- **No applications will be accepted or edited after the deadline.**
- No person may apply for a particular quota hunt more than once. Any person violating this regulation is subject to having their permit and/or hunting privileges revoked and may be subject to prosecution.
- **Permits are not transferable.**

# 2024 CHEROKEE PARTY HUNTS

## CREATING OR JOINING A PARTY

- Applicants may create or join a party. **Parties must have 50-75 party members** to be considered in the drawing.
- A party must be established by an applicant that acts as the party leader. The party leader selects the hunt choices for the party.
- A party number will be assigned to the party leader once their application has been submitted. The party number can be found on the party leader's receipt or on their [www.gooutdoorstennessee.com](http://www.gooutdoorstennessee.com) profile.
- There are two ways to join a party:
  - While the leader submits their application, they can add individuals to their party using the individuals' TWRA ID number and their last name. *Note: the party leader will have to pay any applicable fees for the individuals they add.*
  - The leader can share the party number with the person(s) wishing to join the party. The party members will select "join a party" on their application and put the leader's party number onto their application.

## DRAWING INFORMATION

TWRA's drawing program assigns each application a unique random number. Once the drawing begins, the lowest random number is selected first for review, then each subsequent number is selected for review. When an application is selected for review, the first hunt choice is compared to the remaining quota for that hunt; if there is quota available, the application is awarded that hunt choice. If not, the program examines each subsequent hunt choice, in the order selected on the application, until it finds a hunt choice with quota available or runs out of hunt choices. If no quota is available for any hunt choices on the application, then the application is unsuccessful. If one member of a party is drawn for a hunt, then the entire party is drawn.

There are no priority points associated with this quota hunt.

## CHEROKEE PARTY HUNT CHOICES

### HUNT TABLE INFORMATION

- Weapon type (WT) - the letter that represents the hunting device allowed on the hunt. All bear hunts listed are gun hunts (G), which allows for rifles, muzzleloaders, or archery equipment to be used. Check the Tennessee Hunting and Trapping Guide for more information.
- Date - the dates of the specific hunt choice.
- Quota - the number of permits that can be issued for the specific hunt choice. One party will be drawn for each hunt listed.
- Limit - the bag limit for the duration of the specific hunt choice.
