Dean B. Borsos was appointed as Director of the James H. Quillen VA Medical Center (JHQVAMC), Mountain Home, TN in January 2017. He is responsible for the efficient management and operation of the medical center with 104 medical, surgical, and psychiatric beds, a 120-bed nursing home, a 150-bed domiciliary, and 12 outpatient clinics in Tennessee and Virginia. JHQVAMC is a tertiary care, teaching hospital that provides a full range of patient care services with state-of-the-art technology as well as education and research.



Mr. Borsos is an innovative leader and executive with over 30 years of experience in managing health care systems and business operations as a CEO, CFO and COO, including 27 years at the Department of Defense and Air Force.

An Air Force Veteran, Mr. Borsos served as the Commander of the Air Force Medical Support Agency (AFMSA), Falls Church, VA. AFMSA provides expert consultative leadership and policy development for the entire Air Force Medical Service, supporting the activities of 42,000 personnel serving 2.6 million beneficiaries through 76 military treatment facilities worldwide with a \$6 billion budget.

Mr. Borsos has a master's degree in Health Services Administration from Ohio University and is board-certified in health care administration. He is a Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives (ACHE) and a Credentialed Fellow and Diplomate of the American Academy of Medical Administrators (AAMA). Mr. Borsos' awards include the Legion of Merit Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Department of Defense Meritorious Service Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Air Force Meritorious Service Medal with three oak leaf clusters, being selected as the United States Air Force Medical Resource Management Officer of the Year and earning the AAMA Distinguished Service Award. JHQVAMC earned the 2022 VHA Excellence in Customer Experience Award.
