Mr. Detty serves as the Assistant Director for Data and Operations for the Medical Disability Examination Office (MDEO), Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA). He is an expert advisor to the Executive Director and Deputy Executive Director, leading the day-to-day operational activities for VBA’s contract medical disability examination program providing approximately 150,000 Compensation & Pension (C&P) examinations for Veterans and Service Members each month.



In this role, Mr. Detty has overseen the steady expansion of the program from 289,428 completed examinations in Fiscal Year 2016 to 2,388,739 completed examinations in Fiscal Year 2023. This is a direct result of MDEO’s efforts to increase the number of examination providers, successfully leverage existing systems, and improve the technology utilized by claims processors when ordering examinations to ensure Veterans receive timely, high-quality examinations worldwide.

Mr. Detty was raised in Baltimore, Maryland and served his country honorably in the United States Marine Corps. Married with 2 children, he enjoys spending time with family and friends.
