- Note vs. Communication. A Note Record should be used to communicate important information to another VSO or CSO. A Communication Record should be used to document communication between the VSO or CSO and a third party, such as the Veteran, a dependent or VA.
- **Veteran-Related or Claim-Related Record.** You can create a Note Record as <u>either</u> a Veteran-Related or Claim-Related Record.
  - A Veteran Note Record will not ♦ be visible in a Claim Record.
  - o A Claim Note Record will not \( \rightarrow \) be visible in the Veteran Record.
- Attaching a File. You can attach a file to either a Veteran or Claim Note Record. It will not be available in the Veteran Document Record unless added separately.
  - o 👉 If you delete the Note Record, the file is also deleted.
- **Q Scan for Note Alerts.** Note Alerts indicate that a Veteran record has important information a user should view before interacting with that Veteran.
- Notes & Communications = Better Customer Service. Taking a few minutes to add concise Note and/or Communication Records will benefit all TVB users.
