Personal Nursing Care

Our multi-disciplinary team develops an individual care plan for each resident including medication management, assistance in daily living activities, wound care, and nutritional status management.



Rehabilitation Services

Our therapy programs consist of screening and evaluation by our skilled therapy team to determine an individualized treatment plan to maximize each resident's functional independence.

Admission Requirements

Veterans who were honorably discharged from active service and who also meet at least one of the following requirements:

- Resident of Tennessee at the time of admission.
- Veteran who was born in Tennessee.
- Entered the U.S. Armed Forces in Tennessee.
- Tennessee address is official Home of Record on Veteran's Military Record.
- Has immediate family member who serves as primary caregiver and is a resident of Tennessee.
- Spouse or Gold Star parent are eligible for admission on a space available basis.

***Must supply copy of Veteran Discharge Papers (DD214) prior to admission. If spouse, will additionally need Marriage Certificate & Death Certificate if applicable.*



Accepted Payment Sources

- VA Reimbursement - Honorably discharged veterans receive a VA Per Diem which reduces the daily room and board rate. Qualified veterans with a service connected disability may receive additional VA funds for their care.
- Medicare - Certain medical requirements qualify the applicant for a Medicare reimbursed stay.
- Medicaid - Residents must be approved both financially and medically for reimbursement. Applicants will be evaluated for possible Medicaid benefits prior to or at the time of admission.
- HMO/Private Insurance - Business office staff members can provide assistance with completing forms.
- Private Pay - Utilized if other payment sources do not cover cost.
