Summary

Over the month, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained the same at 3.5% over the month.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased to 3.5% from 3.3%.

Over the month, total nonfarm employment increased by 6,100 jobs. The largest increases were in Professional & Business Services, Education & Health Services, and Trade, Transportation, & Utilities.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased by 22,900 jobs. The largest increases were in Government, Leisure & Hospitality, and Education & Health Services.






Unemployment Rates - Tennessee Seasonally Adjusted - 2023 to 2025
