

The Quarterly Meeting of the Board of Boiler Rules - June 11, 2025

The Quarterly Meeting of the Board of Boiler Rules was held on June 11, 2025, and chaired by Dave Baughman. Key highlights include:

1. **Meeting Proceedings:** The meeting was called to order at 9:01 AM, and introductions were made. The agenda was adopted with one amendment, removing J&S Professionals Services, LLC from New Repair License Applications.
2. **Approval of Minutes:** The March 12, 2025, meeting minutes and transcript were approved.
3. **Reports:** Chief Jimmy Watson presented inspection and violation reports, while Assistant Chief Alex Cass provided a variance report.
4. **Old Business:** No items were discussed.
5. **New Business:**
 - **Variance Requests:**
 - Maury Regional Medical Center's request for an Attendant Variance Approval for remote-control boiler systems was approved.
 - Domtar Kingsport Mill's request to extend internal boiler inspection intervals was discussed but not approved; further inspection was recommended.
 - Tennessee Mills' request for a TN Special to operate a wood-fired boiler for food-grade pallet treatment was approved upon inspection.
 - **Repair License Applications:** Licenses were approved for Turn2 Specialty Companies, LLC, Triosim Corporation, and Universal Machine & Tool Co, Inc.
6. **Board Cases & Interpretations:**
 - Updates to BC 05-11 and BC 12-18 were approved.
 - BC 25-01 was tabled.
7. **Boiler Rules Change:** Fee increases under Rules Chapter 0800-03-03-.14 were approved.
8. **Open Discussion:** General discussion took place.
9. **Upcoming Meetings:** Scheduled for September 10, 2025, and December 10, 2025.
