Summary

Tennessee's April seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased to 14.7% from the March revised rate of 3.3%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased from 3.5% to 14.7% while the national rate increased from 3.6% to 14.7%.

Total nonfarm employment decreased 376,900 jobs from March to April. The largest decreases occurred in leisure/hospitality, manufacturing, and professional/business services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment decreased 341,000 jobs. The largest decreases occurred in leisure/hospitality, manufacturing, and professional/business services.








Unemployment Rates - US & Tennessee Seasonally Adjusted - January 2013 to April 2020
