#### **Summary**

Tennessee's January seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained the same at 3.3% from the revised December seasonally adjusted unemployment rate.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate declined from 3.4% to 3.3% to while the national rate declined from 4.0% to 3.6%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 6,500 jobs from December to January. The largest increases occurred in education/health services, trade/transportation/utilities, and professional/business services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 46,100 jobs. The largest increases occurred in trade/transportation/utilities. leisure/hospitality, and education/health services.




