Summary

Tennessee's May seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained at 5.0% which is the same as the revised April rate

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased from 9.6% to 5.0% while the national rate decreased from 13.3% to 5.8%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 5,000 jobs from April to May. The largest increases occurred in professional/business services, leisure/hospitality, and financial activities.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 231,500 jobs. The largest increases occurred in leisure/hospitality, manufacturing, and professional/business services.








Unemployment Rates - US & TennesseeSeasonally Adjusted - January 2014 to May 2021
