### **Summary**

Tennessee's April seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained the same from March at 3.2%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased from 4.8% to 3.2% while the U.S. rate declined from 6.0% to 3.6%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 7,700 jobs from March to April. The largest increases were in leisure & hospitality, professional & business services, and mining, logging & construction.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 145,600 jobs. The largest increases were in leisure & hospitality, trade, transportation, & utilities, and professional & business services.





Seasonally Adjusted - 2020 to 2022




# **Unemployment Rates - US & Tennessee** Seasonally Adjusted - January 2015 to April 2022
