Summary

Tennessee's September seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained the same at 3.4% from August to September.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted rate unemployment rate decreased from 3.8% to 3.4% while the U.S. rate decreased from 4.7% to 3.5%.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 140,200 jobs. The largest increases were in leisure and hospitality, trade, transportation & utilities, and education and health services.

Total nonfarm employment increased 13,700 jobs from August to September. The largest increases were in trade, transportation, & utilities, leisure and hospitality, and education and health services.






