SUMMARY:

Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained steady at 3.6% in April.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate has increased from 3.5% in April 2025.

Over the month, nonfarm employment increased 1,200 jobs. The largest increases were in construction, durable goods manufacturing, and accommodation and food services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 900 jobs. The largest increases were in health care and social assistance, state government, and administrative, support, and waste services.

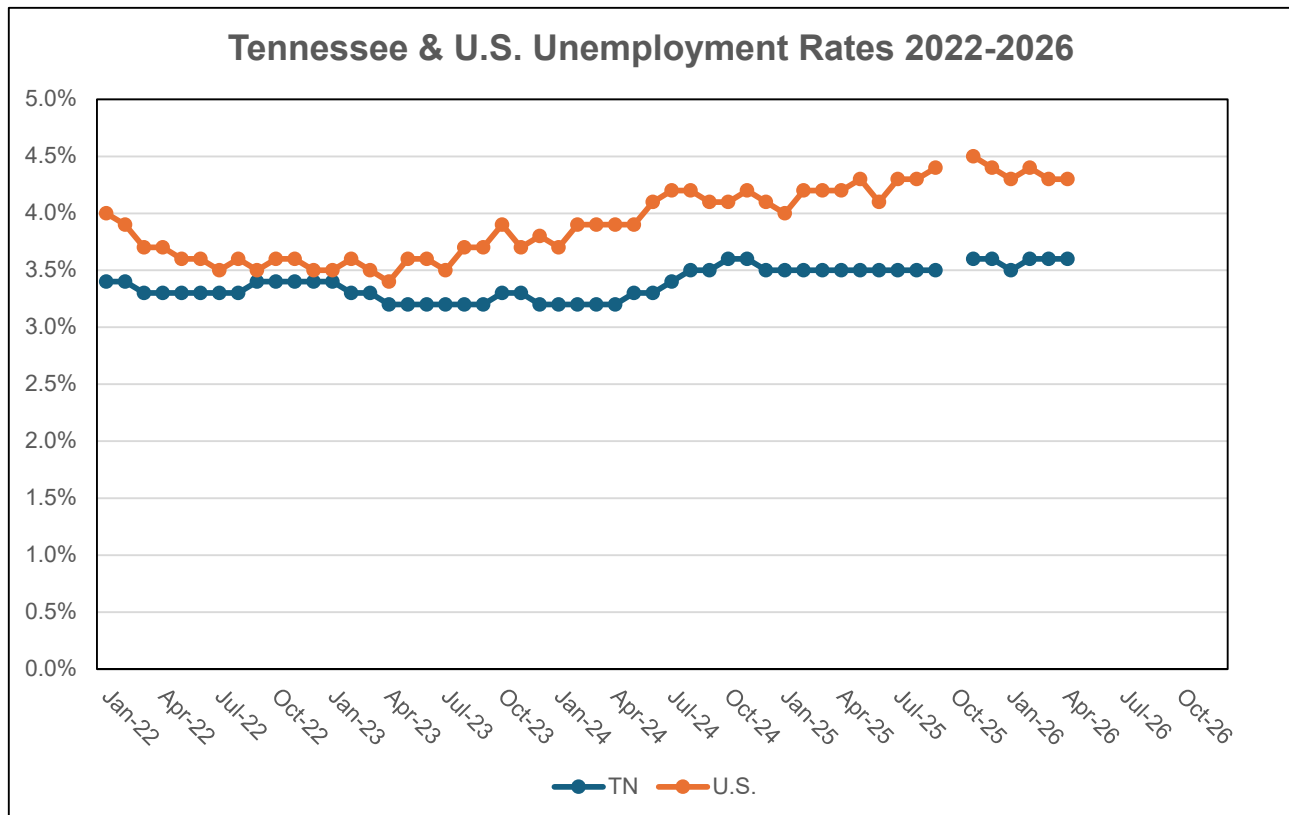
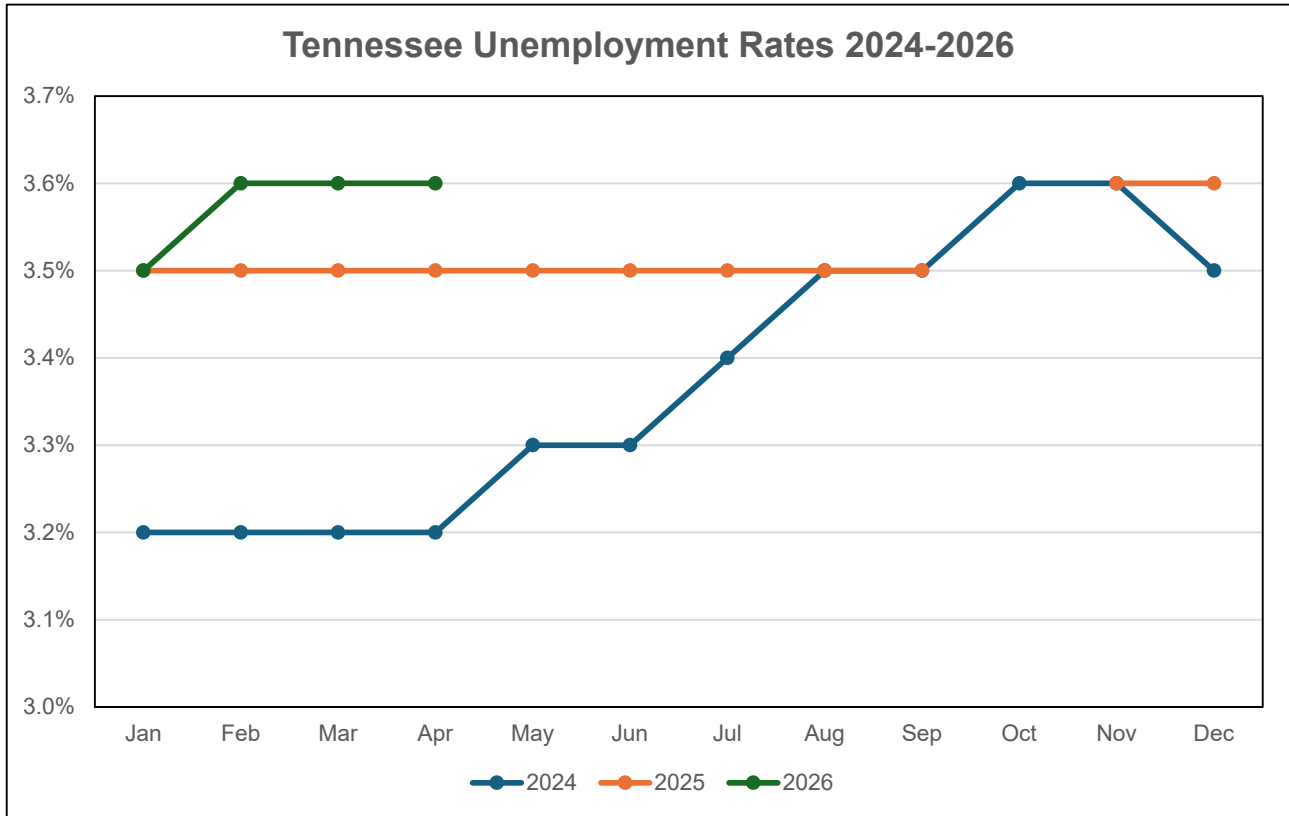
