Kellanova Company Eggo Plant has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent closure. Layoffs are expected to begin June 1, 2024, with all separations complete by November 30, 2024. The company is located at 585 Morrison Rd., Rossville, TN 38066. The total number of affected workers is 142. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on March 26, 2024.

Certain employees at the facility are represented by a collective bargaining agreement and have bumping rights, if applicable, with a permanent and total plant closure. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Area rapid response team, employed by the Greater Memphis Chamber, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected employees. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Board will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow-up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
