Manchester Tank & Equipment Co. has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a temporary layoff on September 8, 2023. The Company intends to restart production at the Facility on or around January 1, 2024. However, it is unclear at this time how many affected employees will have the opportunity to return to work at the Company's Facility. The total number of affected workers is 59. This company is located at 1383 Industrial Blvd,

Crossville, TN 38555. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on July 10, 2023.

The employees at the facility are represented by a collective bargaining agreement. The Upper Cumberland Local Workforce Development Area rapid response team, employed by UC LWBD, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected employees. The Upper Cumberland, Local Workforce Development Board, will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow-up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
