Marsden Services L.L.C. has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent layoff beginning on February 20, 2024, or within 14 days. Marsden Services L.L.C. anticipates most employees will be offered the same or similar positions with the incoming janitorial contractor. The total number of affected workers is 105. This company is located at 4055 New Allen Rd., Memphis, TN 38128. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on January 23, 2024.

The employees at the facility are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Area rapid response team, employed by the Greater Memphis

Chamber, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected employees. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Board will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow-up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
