Aramark Educational Services, LLC has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent closure which is effective May 11, 2019 and May 31, 2019. The total number of affected workers is 122. This company is located at 2000 North Parkway, Memphis, TN 38112. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on April 16, 2019.

The employees at the facility are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Area rapid response team, employed by the Workforce Investment Network, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected

employees. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Board will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
