Emergency Mobile Health Care, LLC has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent closure which is effective February 1, 2019. The total number of affected workers is 207. This company is located at 6972 Appling Farms Parkway, Memphis, TN 38133. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on December 4, 2018.

The employees at the facility are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement. The Local Workforce Development Area Greater Memphis rapid response team, employed by the Workforce Investment Network, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and effected

employees. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Board will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
