LM Farms, LLC dba Gardens Alive! Farms has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent closure which is effective August 3, 2018. The total number of affected workers is 300. This company is located at 6416 Short Mountain Highway, Smithville, TN 37166. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on May 31, 2018.

The employees at the facility are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement. The Local Workforce Development Area 7 rapid response team, employed by the Upper Cumberland Human Resource Agency, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and effected

employees. The Local Workforce Development Board of area 7 will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
