The Prevailing Wage Commission Meeting held on November 19, 2024, was called to order by Chairman Dewayne Scott. The meeting included roll call, adoption of the agenda, approval of the previous meeting's transcript, and a detailed review of the prevailing wage survey data. The primary focus was on proposing the prevailing wage rates for 2025. The Commission discussed and agreed upon the recommended wage rates for various worker classifications based on survey data and previous prevailing wage rates.
