## Prevailing Wage Commission Meeting – March 26,2024 Summary

The Prevailing Wage Commission Meeting for the State of Tennessee was held on March 26, 2024.

Deputy Commissioner Dewayne Scott chaired the meeting, with several key members and representatives present.

The agenda included the call to order, roll call, conflict of interest declarations, adoption of the agenda, approval of meeting minutes from November 20 and 28, 2023; and review and approval of revisions to the Prevailing Wage Commission Rules.

Key points discussed included:

- 1. Adoption of the agenda and approval of previous meeting minutes.
- Detailed review and approval of revisions to the Prevailing Wage Commission Rules, including changes to definitions and classifications of covered workers, and updates to job descriptions and classifications.
- 3. Future meeting dates were set for September 12, November 14, and November 26, 2024, all at 1:30 p.m.
- 4. The process for submitting the revised rules to the Secretary of State's office, including necessary approvals from the Governor's office and the Attorney General's office, and the public hearing process.

The meeting concluded with a motion to adjourn, which was approved.
