Scoring Process

Shown in the table below are five (5) Rating Factors and the maximum points assigned to each factor. A percent value is assigned to each of the five (5) rating factors, correlating to its importance (see Percent of Total Value Column).

Raters will assign points to an applicant's response in each of these rating factors on a scale of 0-5, according to the rating scale shown below. The points allocated to each rating factor are weighted according to the Percent of Total Value to arrive at the Weighted RF Score. The Weighted RF scores are added to calculate the overall score for each proposal. The maximum possible proposal score is 150.

Threshold/Minimum Score

A proposal must meet a threshold of **50%** or a minimum score of **75** total points to be considered for funding.
