

Community Reentry Reinvestment Grant — Scoring Rubric —

Scoring Process

Shown in the table below are five (5) Rating Factors and the maximum points assigned to each factor. A percent value is assigned to each of the five (5) rating factors, correlating to its importance (see Percent of Total Value Column).

Rating Factor	Point Range	Percent of Total Value	Weighted Rating Factors Score
Cover Sheet	0-5	15%	22.5
Proposal / Program Narrative	0-5	40%	60
Demonstrated Effectiveness	0-5	15%	22.5
Funding & Budget Narrative	0-5	10%	15
Letters of Support from Pipeline Partners and Employers	0-5	20%	30

Seven-Point Rating Scale

Raters will assign points to an applicant's response in each of these rating factors on a scale of 0-5, according to the rating scale shown below. The points allocated to each rating factor are weighted according to the Percent of Total Value to arrive at the Weighted Rating Factor Score. The Weighted Rating Factor Scores are added to calculate the overall score for each proposal. The maximum possible proposal score is **150**.

Threshold/ Minimum Score

Proposals must meet a threshold of **50%** or a minimum total score of **75 total** points to be considered for funding.
