Premiere Building Maintenance Corporation has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent layoff effective March 31, 2026. The company will permanently reduce the number of employees (or will permanently close the facility). The total number of affected workers is 154. This company is located at 1416 McCalla Ave, Knoxville, TN 37915. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on February 3, 2026.

The employees at the facility are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement and do not have bumping rights. The East Workforce Development Board's rapid response team, employed by the East Tennessee Human Resources Agency, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected employees. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Board will be responsible for the oversight of, and the continued follow-up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
