Wellpath has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent closure effective September 30, 2026. The affected locations are, 1045 Mullins Station Road, Memphis, TN 38134, 6201 Haley Rd, Memphis, TN 38134, 3420 Old Getwell RD, Memphis, TN 38118, 201 Poplar Ave, Memphis, TN 38103. The total number of affected workers is 119. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on July 31, 2026.

The employees at these facilities are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement, and do not have bumping rights. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Area rapid response team, employed by the Greater Memphis Chamber, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected employees. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Board will be responsible for the oversight of and the continued follow-up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
